It costs us about \$400 per child to run BPM summer programs but they are **free** for all campers because of our fundraising efforts. Similar camps in Nassau charge \$300 - \$400 for what we offer. This means that we are serious about giving the opportunity to attend to those who will value what we offer.

Admission Criteria- We grant admission to students based on listed criteria and welcome applications from everyone!

We cater specifically to kids who:

- Have an interest in the environment and going green.
- Have an interest in arts & culture.
- Are committed to improving themselves academically
- Enjoy working with others and aren't afraid to try new things
- Want to develop their leadership skills and confidence.

Admissions Priority is given to:

- Children who have previously attended the programs
- Children who reside in South Eleuthera
- Children who have older siblings who have attended the program
- Children who demonstrate an interest in what the program offers
- Children who are referred by a teacher or guidance counsellor
- Children of parents who have actively supported or been involved in the camp preparations

Financial Information

- We **require** that all campers take out insurance. The cost of a basic insurance package is

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Step 3: Camp Rules & Expectations, Terms and Conditions

To ensure the safety and wellbeing of our students we require campers to follow these rules. Failure to follow the rules can result in your child's enrolment being cancelled or suspended.

1. ***If late or absent on more than 3 occasions enrollment may be cancelled or suspended.***
2. ***Children must treat others with kindness and respect always. Fighting, profanity, bullying, theft, abuse of camp property and rudeness will not be tolerated and will result in the removal of the child from camp.***
3. ***Any articles that may be considered weapons are not permitted and will be confiscated. Possession of these articles can result in suspension or permanent removal from camp.***
4. ***Children must give their best effort in camp activities and will be recognized for active participation, leadership, teamwork and a positive attitude.***

Camp Terms and Conditions

<p>1. Campers must complete the full program and if participating in Plastic Camp they must participate in the Plastic Pollution Education Event.</p>	<p>2. Our camp program involves activities that may involve going in the water or being on the water. In signing this form, you give full consent for your child to participate in such activities. if you do not want your child to participate in these activities you must inform camp administration and alternative arrangements can be made.</p>
<p>3. BPM is a non-profit organization. To raise money for our programs we take photos and videos of children during camp activities to use in our fundraising materials. Signing this form indicates your consent for your child's picture to be used for such purposes. Images and film are used solely for camp communication and fundraising.</p>	<p>4. We are a safety-first organization and do the utmost to ensure the safety of all campers, signing this form means that you understand neither "Bahamas Plastic Movement" nor any volunteer working for "Bahamas Plastic Movement" are liable in any way for an injury, illness or accident or death occurring during camp activities.</p>
<p>5. A child who has a contagious illness will be asked to remain home until they are recovered.</p>	<p>6. Children's personal property if brought to camp is the responsibility of the child; no camp staff or volunteer is accountable for loss or breakage of a child's personal property.</p>
<p>7. Bahamas Plastic Movement Plastic Camp is a free program; however, all campers are required to have a basic insurance plan. We do not offer student coverage. T-shirts will be made available on the first day of camp at the cost of \$20. Purchase is required.</p>
